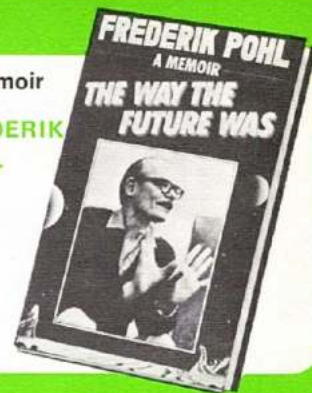


# THE WAY THE FUTURE WAS

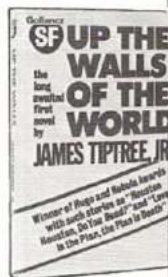

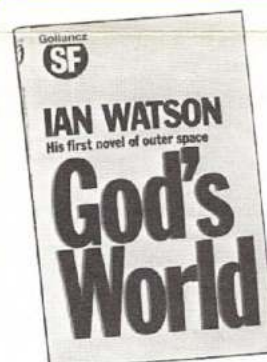
## God's World
