## DRAGON DRUMS

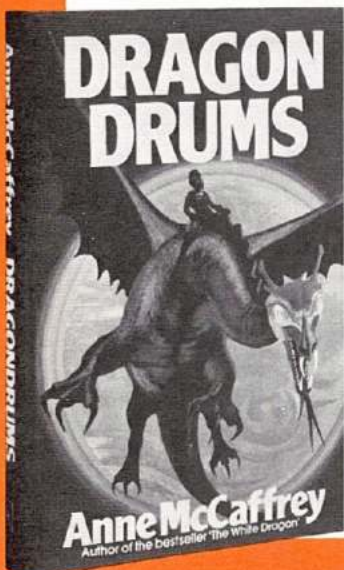
