The beginnings of an answer start to form when Alex Craven becomes involved with his girlfriend Nicole Toupe's experiments with empathic communications between twins. Eventually, accompanied by one of two particularly gifted twins, he leaves Earth for New Carthage – a strange world where a shadow-line civilisation moves in perpetual slow motion to avoid the intolerable daytime heat.

Beyond the shadow-line live primitive aliens – evasive and nomadic – driven by some irresistible compulsion towards a particular place at a particular time.
