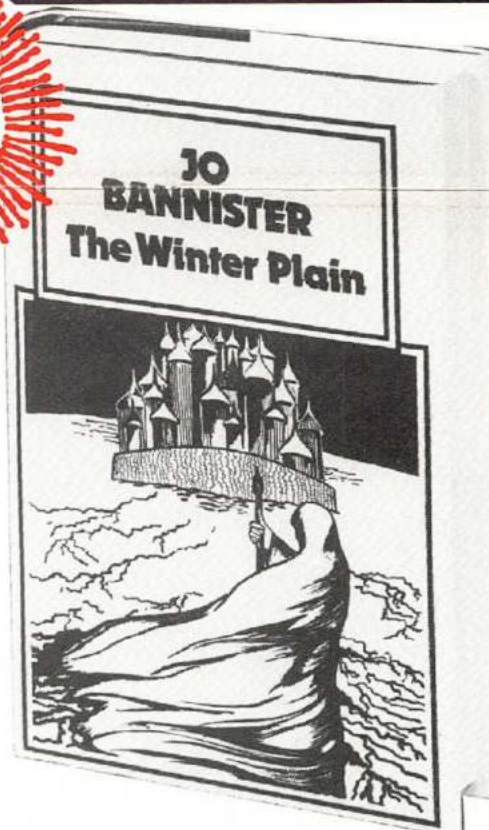
When his bedslave teams up with a nuclear engineer to rescue the last scion of the House of Chad, the results are totally devastating.

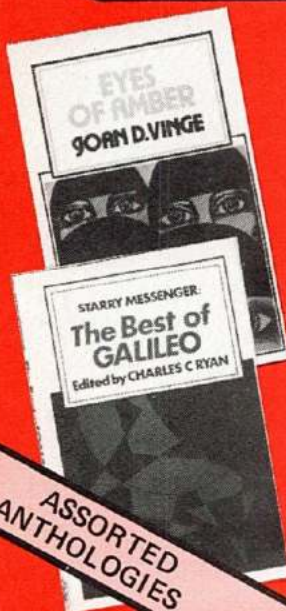
