The Terrans needed it as an overspill from the hysterical crowding of earth; a place to live and breathe and move, without restrictions.

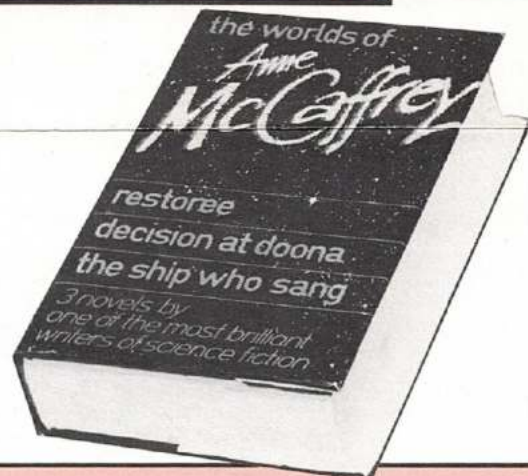
The Hrrubans needed it to revitalise their decadent race, to give them back something of the old pioneering spirit.

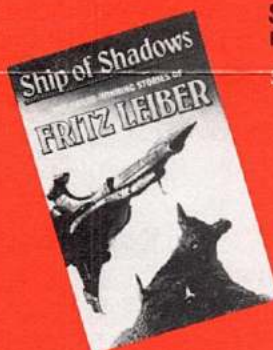

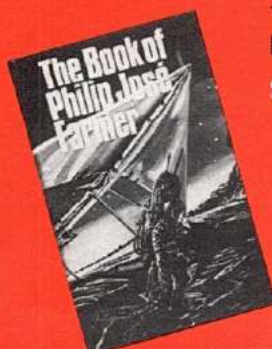

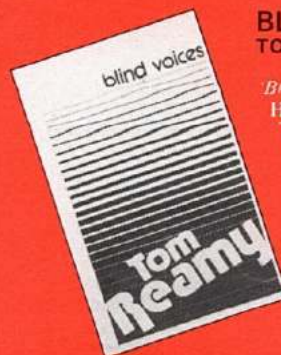
