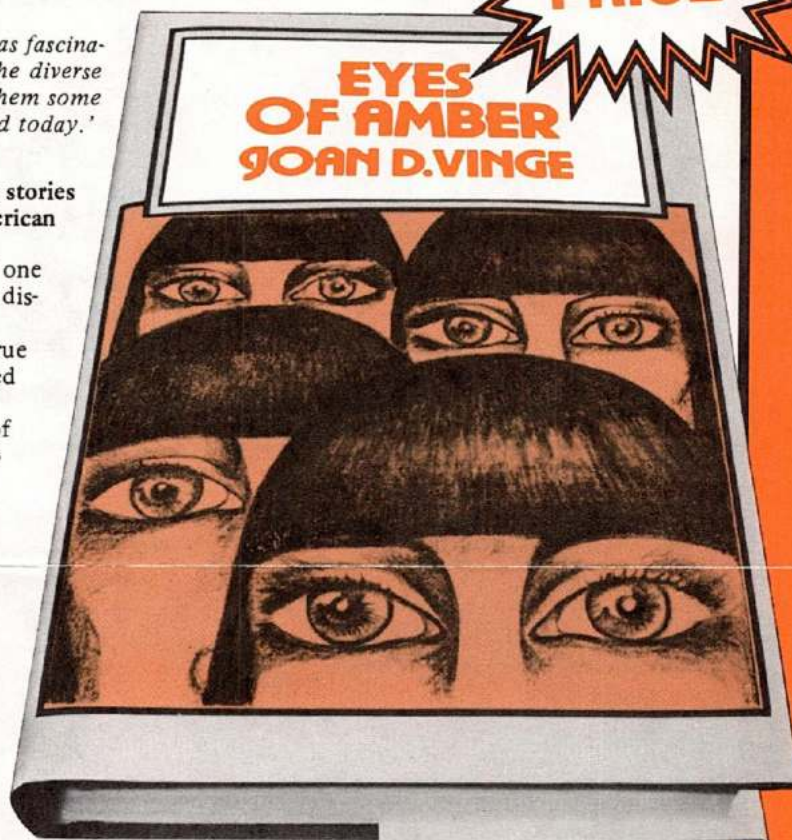

She began publishing sf with *Tin Soldier* in 1974 and rapidly achieved the heights of success when *Eyes of Amber* — the lead story in this new collection — won the Hugo Award for Best Novelette in 1977. Since then she has gone from strength to strength, gaining a Hugo nomination for her short novel, *Fireship*, and a second Hugo Award for her full-length sf novel, *The Snow Queen*. Her husband, Vernor Vinge, is a successful sf author in his own right.
