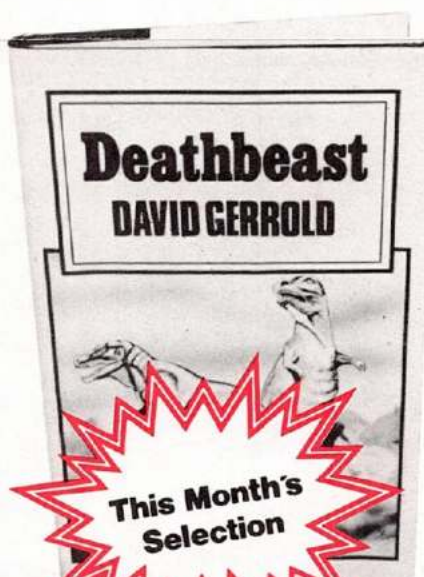
A Savage Encounter at the Dawn of Time
