Great Stories of Science Fiction is no exception to the rule of a well-balanced selection of stories by prominent authors, albeit American, and has the added touch of greatness in the fact that its editor, Murray Leinster, is himself an outstanding science fiction writer. One such who has personally had a great deal to do with the moulding of this specialised literature over a period of many years. The first record I have of him is a story entitled "The Runaway Skyseraper" in *Amazing Stories*, June 1926, but I believe that he had stories published before that time in magazines which did not specialise in science fiction.

Since that date he has had over one hundred stories published in the medium, many under pseudonyms, and more recently several book-length novels. A more expert choice of editorship would be difficult to conceive, and Mr. Leinster has chosen his stories with great care and understanding.
